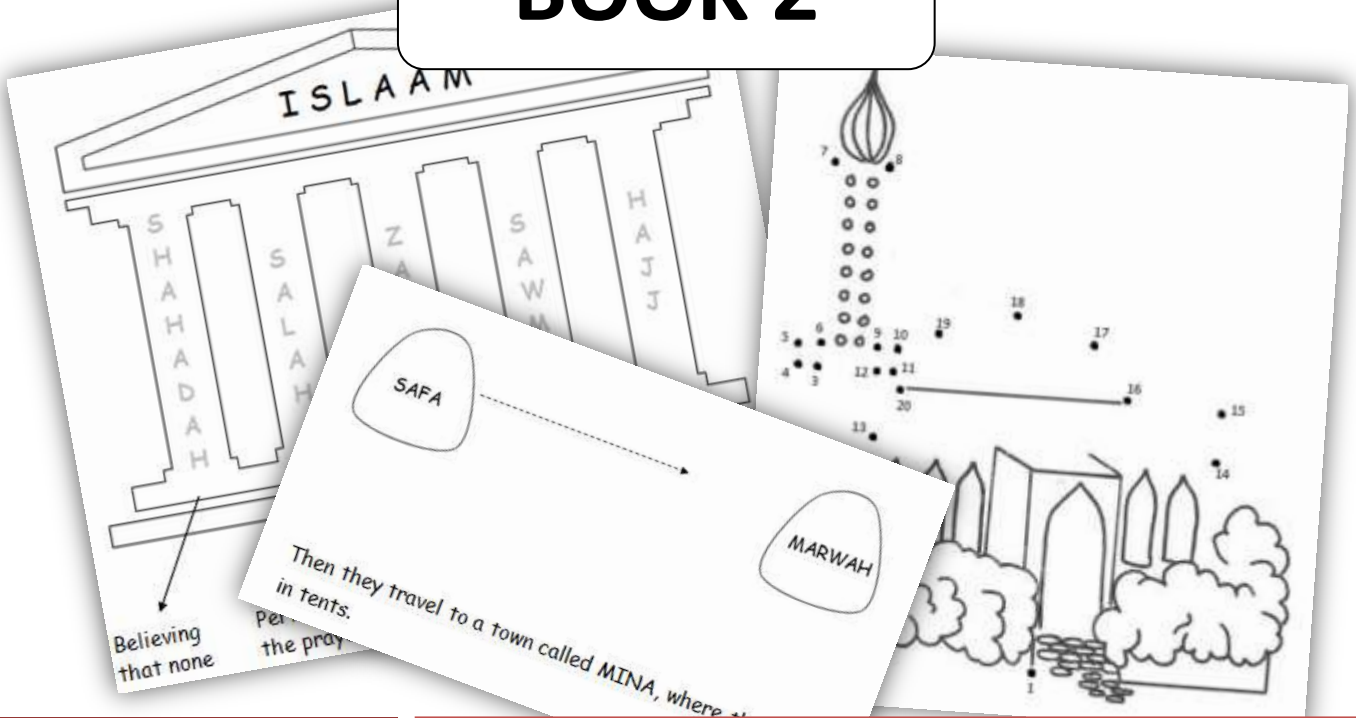

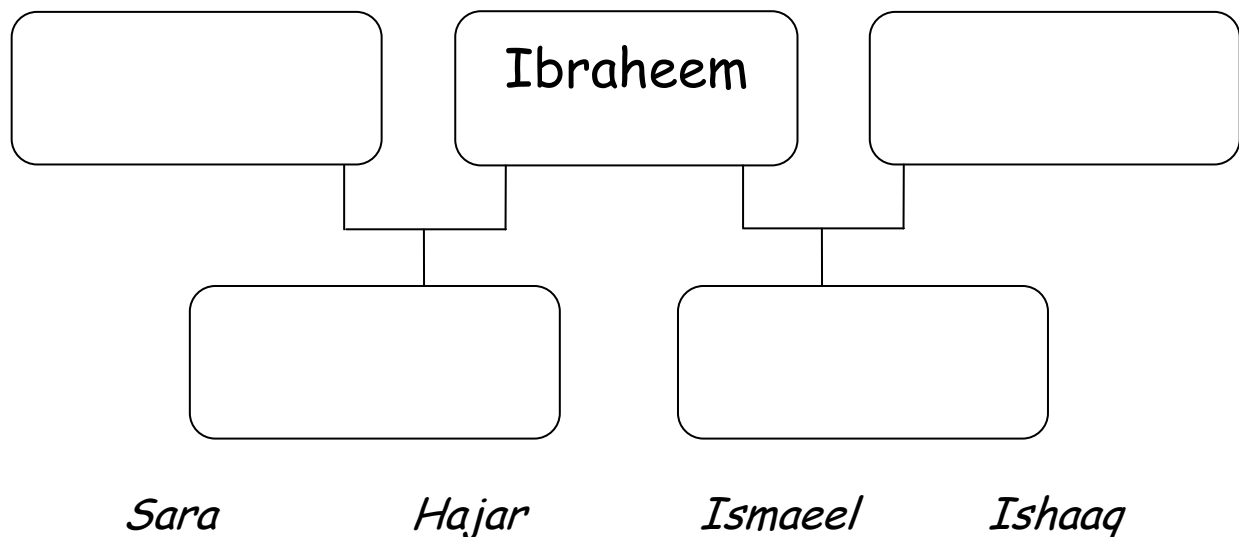

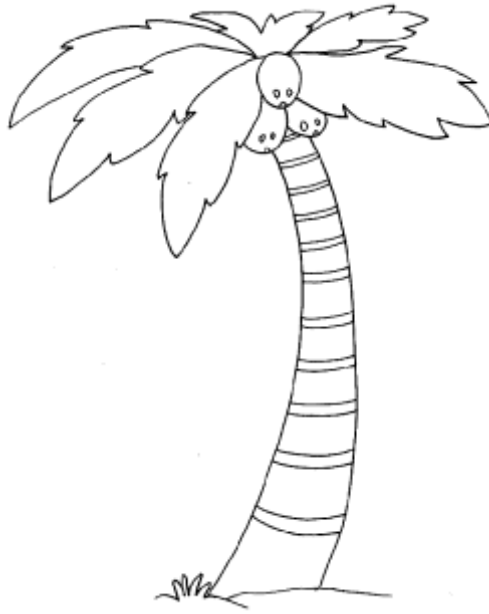
The Story of Ibraheem (upon him be peace)

Below are the steps of the Hajj. Put the steps in the right order. Number 1 has been done for you.

Walk around the KAABAH seven times. This is called TAWAAF.

Put on your special HAJJ clothes called IHRAAM.

Go to MINA to sleep in tents.

Sleep under the stars in MUZDALIFA.

Make DUA to Allah in ARAFAT.

Throw seven stones at the pillars in JAMARAT. This is to remember Ibraheem (upon him be peace) and Ismaeel (upon him be peace)

SACRIFICE an animal to remember Ibraheem (upon him be peace)'s sacrifice.

Do TAWAAF around the KAABAH again.

Men then SHAVE their hair. Women only cut a LITTLE bit of their hair.
